



## Chateau de Campuget is The Jewel of the Costières de Nîmes

Château de Campuget, in Costières de Nîmes, is a beautiful wine property dating back to 1640.

The soil is typical for the region with lots of stones, forcing the roots deep down to find water in the lower layers of clay contributing additional character to the wine. The property is managed by Franck-Lin.

Report on the 2012 Vintage: Rhône Valley winemakers can give themselves a well-deserved pat on the back: initial tastings indicate excellent flavour potential and very good balance. Inter-Rhône's own oenologists report that 2012's wines are defined by their elegance, balance and freshness. "Tannins are very much in evidence, but they are supple and rounded", so says Françoise Dijon, Head of Quality Analysis at Inter-Rhône; she continues, "It would be tempting to draw comparisons with 2007 – both show elegance, finesse and an excellent flavour profile."



## Le Campuget Blanc 2013

**Grapes: 70% Grenache Blanc , 30% Viognier.**

*We created the Le Campuget range of fresh and aromatic wines to display wines produced using the emblematic grapes from the Rhône Valley. These are wines that are easy to drink with friends...*



**Night Harvest.** Fermentation takes place over 10 and 15 days. The temperature was controlled around 54° and 56°F.

**Tasting Notes:** Le Campuget Grenache Viognier 2013 is a fresh, subtle blend of Grenache Blanc and Viognier from the Costières de Nîmes area of France's southern Rhone. It shows citrus, floral aromas, with elegant, fresh flavours.

**Serving Suggestions:** A great summer accompaniment to salads and fish dishes.



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
