



## Chateau de Campuget is The Jewel of the Costières de Nîmes

Château de Campuget, in Costières de Nîmes, is a beautiful wine property dating back to 1640.

The soil is typical for the region with lots of stones, forcing the roots deep down to find water in the lower layers of clay contributing additional character to the wine. The property is managed by Franck-Lin.

**The Wine Spectator Report on the 2014 Vintage:** “The good news: Quality for whites is excellent and reds can be outstanding”. “Promising grapes: Viognier, Marsanne and Roussanne wines in the north look excellent; the south’s supporting players Syrah and Mourvèdre performed very well.”



## Le Campuget Blanc 2014

**Grapes: 70% Grenache Blanc , 30% Viognier.**

*We created the Le Campuget range of fresh and aromatic wines to display wines produced using the emblematic grapes from the Rhône Valley. These are wines that are easy to drink with friends...*

**Night Harvest.** Fermentation takes place over 10 and 15 days. The temperature was controlled around 54° and 56°F.

**Tasting Notes:** Le Campuget Grenache Viognier 2013 is a fresh, subtle blend of Grenache Blanc and Viognier from the Costières de Nîmes area of France’s southern Rhone. It shows citrus, floral aromas, with elegant, fresh flavours.

**Serving Suggestions:** A great summer accompaniment to salads and fish dishes.



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
