




Dusted Valley and Boomtown by Dusted Valley

WAHLUKE SLOPE

Blend: 90% Petite Sirah, 10% Syrah

Appellation: Wahluke Slope

Vineyard: Northridge, Stone Tree

Wine Analysis:

- 6.59 grams/L Total Acidity
- 3.63 pH
- 15.1% Alcohol

Techniques: Tank and bin fermented with gentle pump overs and punch downs. 21-31 day maceration. Aged on fine lees and racked once before bottling.

Oak Program: 35% New 500L Wisconsin Puncheons

You are welcome and encouraged to Stain your Teeth on this. We are not making any excuses for this big bad boy. From the beginning it seemed to have a life force all its own. I told Corey he should have given the Petite Sirah a little direction. But, Nooo! He said the wine could find its own way through this cruel world.
